Description:

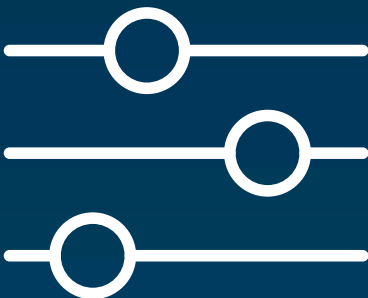
Organize files with new and improved tagging capabilities. Users can categorically tag files for easier searching and filtering and mark files as "Untagged" to identify which files need review.

Simplifies the process of keeping large numbers of files up to date, reducing manual effort.

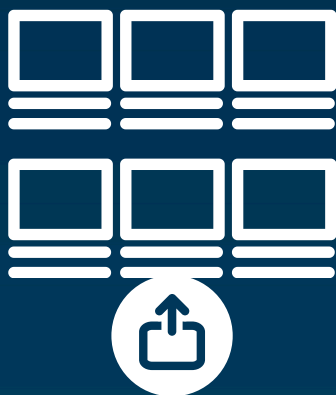
• Customize Grid Columns
